In accordance with the revised asset revaluation program meAtuthority anticipates receiving draft revaluations of fixed assets in July 2023 and consequintentials to complete the preparation of the Draft Statement of counts by 31 August 2023 At that time the Responsible Financial Officer with insider the requirement to sign and certify the Accounts in compliance with the relevant regulations

Further to completion, the Draft Acoots will be subject to public inspection and external audit as required by the Accounts & Audit (Wales) Regulations and the Public Audit Wales Act. The Authority intends to the Draft Accounts b 1 August 2023 as it is considered that accounts published at 31 July 2023 would be materially incorrect and misleading to the user. Subject to completion of the audithe Accounts will be resented to the Governance & Audit Committee 30 November 2023 for consideration and approval.
